

## LEMONS:

Argentina sent a lot more lemon tons to northern and southern Europe to date. Chile (to week 25) is down on the last two years. Both South Africa and Argentina have been up on 2012 in the first half of the season. South Africa is expected to have a poor second peak this year.

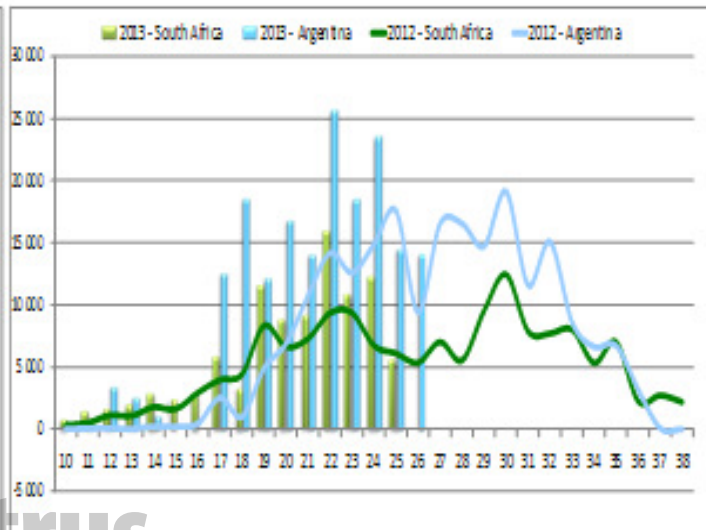
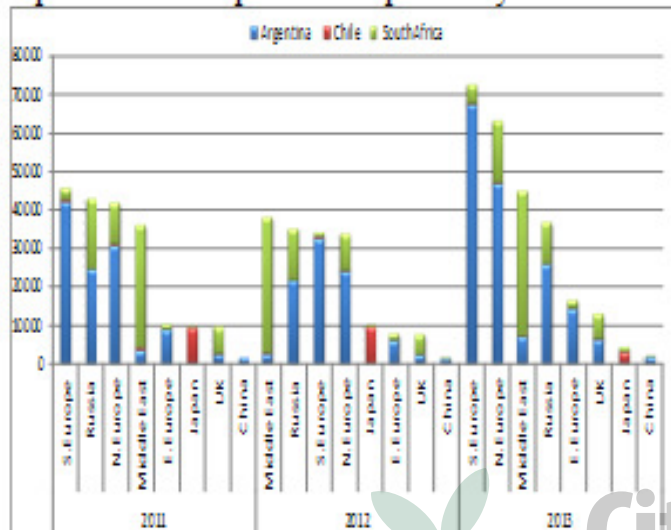


Fig 1: Tons lemons sent from South Africa to main markets

Weekly exports volumes (tons) of South African soft citrus are similar to previous years. Argentina has sent more to Russia and less soft citrus to Europe and UK.

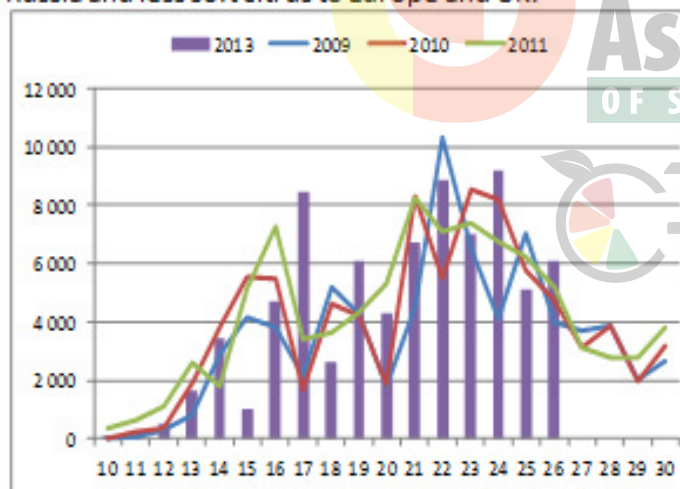


Fig 3: 2013 weekly soft citrus exported from South Africa.

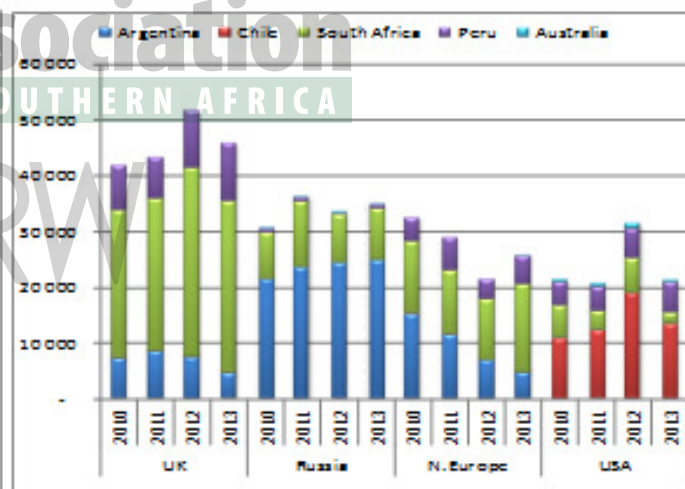


Fig 4: SHAFPE soft citrus exports to main markets.
