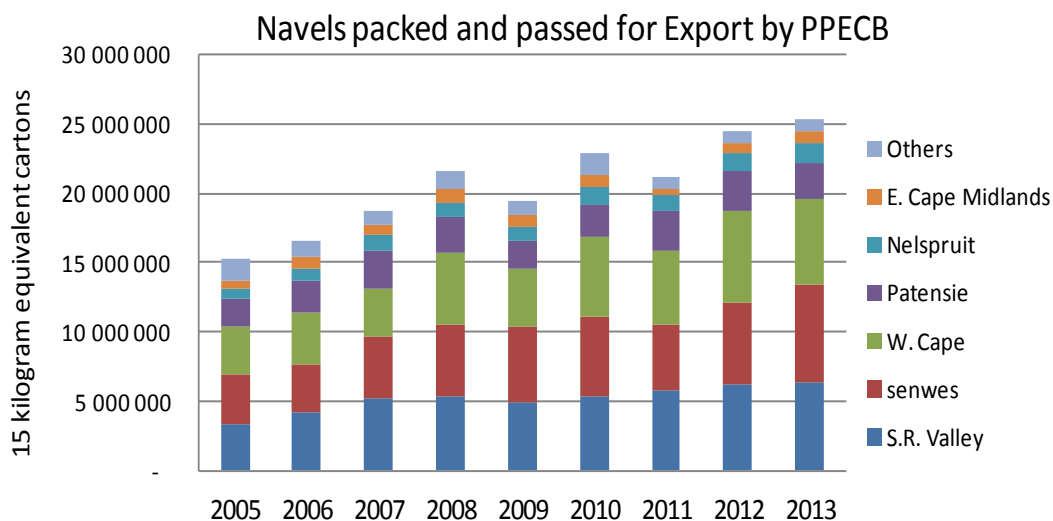


# Citrus Spotlight: SA Navel Trends

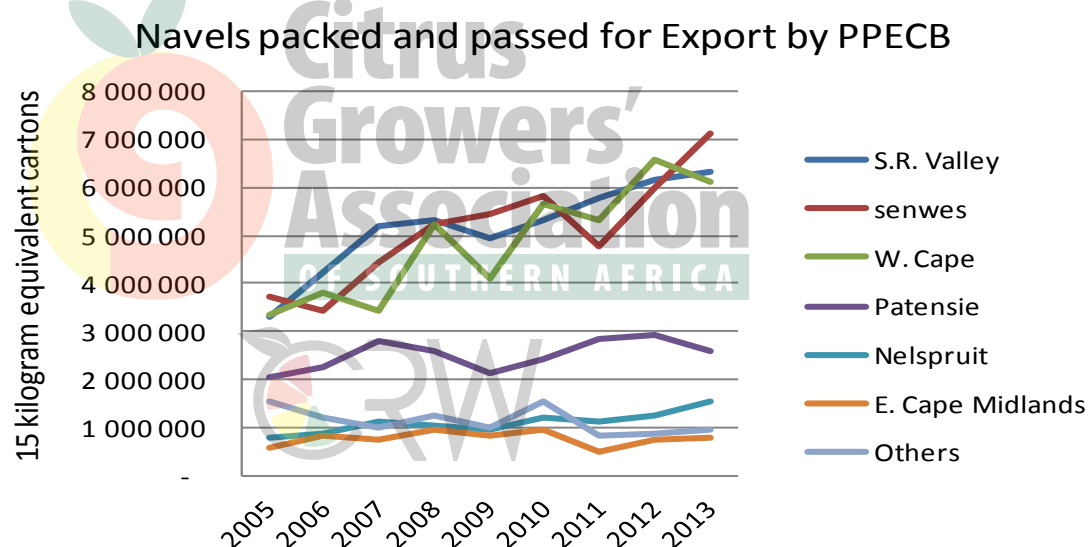

There has been a growth of over 10 million cartons in the South African Navel passed for export since 2005.



The three main growing areas, namely Sunday's River Valley, Senwes and the Western Cape have been responsible for this growth whilst the smaller regions have remained relatively static.



As can be seen from the graph on the right, the growth in volume has come mainly from the crop harvested from week 28 onwards.
