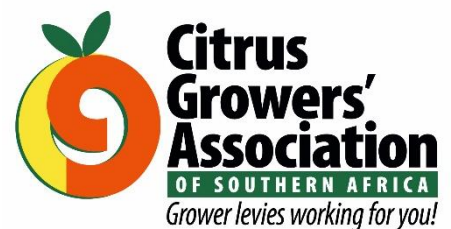

Infrastructure built, erected, or bought on or for the farm.

5. What is the primary consideration during orchard establishment?

Production potential.

6. What determines the amount and size of infrastructure required on a farm?

The size of the farm.

7. What are access roads?

Roads that lead to and from the farm.

8. What is communication infrastructure?

Telecommunication and radio systems.

9. How should boundary fencing be erected?

According to the title deed for the farm.

10. What is the primary function of roads?

Providing a surface giving good foot and wheel traction over a range of weather conditions.

11. Who supplies electricity to farms in South Africa?

Eskom or certain municipalities who sub-contract to Eskom.
