1. What is production stock?

All the materials, goods, and supplies that are required for citrus production.

2. What are the two types of production stock?

Raw materials and finished products.

3. What are raw materials in citrus production?

The stock that goes 'into' producing the citrus fruit.

4. What are finished products in citrus production?

Your fruit, or fruit products like juice or oil, once production is complete.

5. What is inventory control?

The process of managing and monitoring your stock, including knowing the amounts, location, and condition of all your various stock items.

6. What is FIFO?

'First in first out' refers to a practice where the oldest stock in the store must be used first.

7. What are the risks of using paper-based stock management systems?

They can be time-consuming, inefficient and carry the risk of human error.

8. Which stock management systems are recommended for bigger farms?

Electronic stock management systems which can automate stock management practices.

9. What is a stock audit?

The practice of physically going through your stock to see that your records line up with what is actually in the storeroom.
